## By Rail

Manchester Town Hall is 10 minutes by taxi from Piccadilly or Victoria stations. It is 10 minutes' walk from Oxford Road or Deansgate stations.



## By Tram

Manchester Town Hall is 5 minutes' walk from the G-MEX tram stop or St Peter's Square tram stop. The tram runs directly from Piccadilly Station.



## By Air: Manchester International Airport

From the airport to Manchester Town Hall takes approximately 20 minutes by taxi. Trains from the airport to Piccadilly or Oxford Road stations take about 20 minutes.
