However, if done with a parent, this is all the ‘prior learning’ needed!</p>	<p>What does it lead to next?</p> <p>A study of the 1960s as a decade and its influence on society today</p> <p>(Sporting achievements, inventions, discoveries, fashion changes, music changes, etc.)</p>	

Explanation: How should this resource be used? The resource provided here can aid children in a self-research project on The Beatles. It breaks their amazing musical career down into three parts and asks them to compare and contrast all three 'periods' of their music with the events going on in society at the time. It provides a brilliant opportunity for parents and pupils to fall in love with the music of this highly influential band as they research the lives of these four famous Liverpudlians!

You can use the resource as a prompt to create your own three posters by printing on A4 or A3 – you decide! It's up to you. Be sure to use the research questions in your research on the internet, though.

How to use this resource: Each Beatles time period is broken into two. For the first section, simply use the internet to research the questions provided. Be sure to focus in on the key events in the time period and the music of that time. It would be easy to jump around to look at a variety of different bits of their music and events in their life but be disciplined in making sure that you focus on each time period and work through the 'story of the Beatles' as you go though. For the second section, look at key events that took place for each time period. Children – you make a decision with your parents about things that were 'significant' (which means important) in that particular section of time in the decade.

Repeat for the next two sections. In my opinion, it's essential that you listen to their music while you research. That will give you a feel for what they were really like. There are loads of great YouTube videos of them playing live. See if you can notice how they change over time.

NOTE FOR PARENTS: There is two bits of sensitive information that might come up during research. For example, when The Beatles travelled to Hamburg, they began their career playing in music venues that were previously strip clubs. Furthermore, later on in their career, they were introduced to drugs by other musicians. These references are only made on the Wikipedia page suggested. ***If you do not want to discuss these things with your children, then please avoid this website – all the other websites do not include this information.*** A clear note is made next to any links.

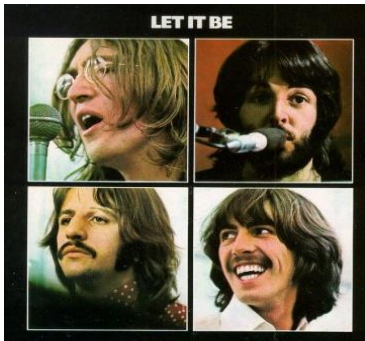

The Beatles: Key Events and Their Music (1967-1970)

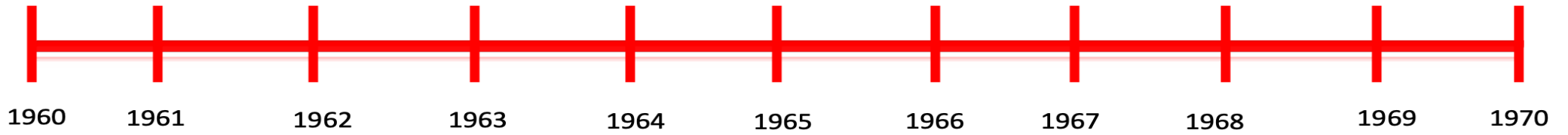
Key Events in History – 1967 - 1970
