#### How to fill in the forms

#### The Gift Aid declaration form

This is our standard Gift Aid declaration form and we'd ask you to complete this even if you have previously given us a Gift Aid declaration (the declaration needs to be confirmed every year to confirm you have/will not claim income tax relief on your annual subscription fee).

#### The Gift Aid Eligibility Form

This form is required by Her Majesty's Revenue & Customs to confirm that you have not claimed income tax relief on the cost of your subscription. The form goes back six years, please tick the boxes for each of the years you have not claimed income tax relief on your HA subscription.

Tax claimed by the Charity:

- The Charity will reclaim 28p of tax for every £1 you gave up to 5 April 2008.
- The Charity will reclaim 25p of tax for every £1 you gave on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay the charity an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.

If you pay income tax at a higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on you Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.
